

Minister Of Natural Resources Happy With Aspen Valley

With a new Board of Directors and bylaws in place Aspen Valley Wildlife Sanctuary in Rosseau is back on track. Former staff made waves about 4 months ago, levying allegations of animal cruelty and mistreatment.

The Ministry of Natural Resources has conducted monthly inspections and Minister Donna Cansfield says although they did find some issues of concern like animal species being too close together and animals being visible to the public, they did not find any proof to the allegations of animal abuse.

She says the Sanctuary is working hard to fix the identified areas of concern and she's pleased with the relationship the M-N-R has with them. Board Chair, Paul Harris says on the Aspen Valley website the new Board consists of 6 members and a new General Manager with a full compliment of staff.
